Entre-Deux-Mers, Château Grand-Jean £19.00

*The Dulon Family have been making wine at Chateau Grand Jean since 1750 in the Entre-Deux-Mers which is perhaps the most picturesque part of Bordeaux. This small estate originally started with just 12 hectares. (Sauvignon Blanc).*

Meursault "Clos du Corbins" Domaine Bitouzet Prieur £50.30

*Vincent Bitouzet is the current family member to inherit the 11 hectare domaine, 3 hectares is planted to Chardonnay and the harvest is still done by hand, then fermented and aged in barrel. (Chardonnay)*

## ROSÉ WINE SPECIALS

Domaine Begude Pinot Noir Rosé £21.00

*Wine has been produced on this small property just outside the medieval town of Carcassonne since 1530 due to a unique micro-climate made possible by the formation of the foothills (Pinot Noir).*

## RED WINE SPECIALS

Chateau Maris Organic Syrah £19.50

*Produced by Bertie Eden who makes his wines according to biodynamics, a step beyond organics to a philosophy that sees the soil, the plants, the animals that live there, the people that pick, press and ferment the grapes and the juices in the tank itself as part of a living system. (Syrah)*

Viña Tres Palacios, Cholqui, Maipo Valley £20.00

*Viña Tres Palacios, is a family-run wine cellar established in 1996 by the Palacios family. The vineyard is situated in a sub valley called Cholqui which means "birds head" in the native language. (Merlot).*

Astrolabe Pinot Noir, New Zealand £35.40

*Simon Waghorn owner and chief wine maker at Whitehaven won gold at the 37th International Wine and Spirit Competition in London from the South Island area of Marlborough. Just to make sure of quality he hand picks his grapes, probably with some help from friends. (Pinot Noir)*

Bollinger Special Cuvée, N.V. £59.50  
*Madame Bollinger once said of this Champagne "I drink it when I'm happy and when I'm sad. Sometimes I drink it when I'm alone. When in company it is obligatory. I trifle with it if I'm not hungry and drink it when I am. Otherwise I never touch it, unless I'm thirsty."*

*Exclusively vintage Champagne, unique but timeless.*

Krug Grande Cuvée £123.00  
*Still using small cask fermentation, and grapes harvested over a number of years, ensures a Champagne of the highest possible quality.*

*Located in Eguisheim, the cradle of Alsatian winemaking, Paul Zinck has established a special place in the region. This father and son duo have found, in essence, a balance in winemaking, between traditional craftsmanship and the contributions of new techniques. (Riesling)*

Sancerre, Domaine Hubert Brochard

£29.80

*From Sauvignon grapes grown round the village of Sancerre. Hubert Brochard has just won commendations at the Mâcon Grand Concours de Vin 2006 (Sauvignon Blanc).*

Puligny-Montrachet 'Les Levrans'

£50.80

*Vincent Bitouzet can trace his roots in Burgundy back to 1802 when his his great-great-grandfather was the Mayor of Auxey Duresse. He is a dedicated Burgundian classicist and his wines reflect this (Chardonnay).*

Pinot Grigio, Le Marsure

£24.10

*It was in 1971 that the history of Le Marsure began with Teresa Rais in Italy's area of Friuli. Today 70% of the winery's production is Pinot Grigio and it is considered an exceptional expression of the local land. (Pinot Grigio)*

Backsberg, Sauvignon Blanc, South Africa

£25.70

*This wine helped earn the Backsberg Winery a place in the top 100 world wineries of the year in the Wine & Spirits Magazine, New York. The only South African winery to achieve this (Sauvignon Blanc).*

Astrolabe Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand

£29.30

*Simon Waghorn owner and chief wine maker at Whitehaven won gold at the 37th International Wine and Spirit Competition in London from the South Island area of Marlborough. Just to make sure of quality he hand picks his grapes, probably with some help from friends. (Sauvignon Blanc)*

*Before we put our label on a wine we really had to get to know the people behind it. Brigitte and Claude Robert are the third generation to run the estate since granddad bought it in 1954. They revel in making what they describe as “vins plaisirs” and they succeed with a disarming charm, friendliness and soul. (Merlot/ Grenache).*
- Château Les Arromans, Bordeaux £17.00  
*Les Arromans was created by Jean Duffau, in 1965 and is now in the capable hands of his son Joel. Moulon is in the classic Bordeaux area just outside St Emilion. (Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot)*
- Côtes du Rhône, Château de Montfaucon £24.60  
*Rodolphe de Pins runs this 11th century château having first cut his teeth in Australia, California and the mighty “Vieux Télégraphe” Châteauneuf across the river (Syrah).*
- Château Bellevue Peycharneau, Bordeaux Supérieur £26.20  
*The Laulan family use the same techniques as the first growth properties for this wine. The grapes are grown on a small 31-acre vineyard on the east side of the Gironde river near Bergerac (Cabernet Sauvignon & Franc/Merlot).*
- Little B, Médoc RB £27.20  
*This modern Médoc is the creation of winemaker Bruno Secret, produced from the younger vines of the prestigious Château Bournac and aged in American oak (Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot).*
- Domaine Maris £28.70  
'La Touge' Minervois La Livinière RB  
*Domaine Maris is at the centre of Bertie Eden's Languedoc operation. The great nephew of Sir Anthony Eden makes his wines using biodynamic methods; organic and no pesticides or herbicides (Syrah).*
- Backsberg Pinotage £24.50  
*Backsberg has been chosen as one of the top 100 Wineries of the Year. This estate has been run by the Back's family for 3 generations and exported there wine to France after the second world war when there was a shortage. (Pinotage)*

Château Martinat, Côtes de Bourg <i>Made from 40-year-old vines from a tiny estate belonging to the outstanding winemaker Stephane Donze (Merlot/Malbec).</i>	£30.80
Pommard, Domaine Pascal Pouhin <i>This estate has recently started to bottle its own wine and only produces a small amount each year (Pinot Noir).</i>	£38.50
Rioja Crianza 'Azabache', Bodegas Aldeanueva, Spain <i>From a state-of-the-art cooperative winery, comes a traditional style Rioja, aged in French and American oak. (Tempranillo).</i>	£17.50 / £24.10
